 - I have used the IC portal requests for several years. It is very helpful and useful. The only thing is your courses have to be set up for "student requests" on the Course set up.
 - We have only had IC for one full year. We are not set up to do requests this way. I have been watching LOTS of IC videos trying to learn and I feel very techy but it is overwhelming. The google form was much simpler!!

- Our district had concern with inviting parents to the classrooms due to confidentiality for other students. Has that been an issue?
 - When inviting parents they only see things for their child- they can get a daily or weekly report.
 - yes, it was a big discussion. I believe if you use the guardian option, the parent does not see the other students, only their own.
 - Main take-away: Add parents/caretakers as "guardians" not "students" when adding them to google classroom
- What about students who don't have access to computers or the internet?
 - Many schools are loaning out chromebooks
 - Our school district is able to use transportation dollars to pay for internet for students who don't have access and can't get on spectrum
 - Cricket was offering hot spots
- Staying connected with school staff/team

- Our teachers are all on a marco polo account and we check in with each other. We also do a weekly meeting virtually for all of our staff.
- our Elementary Principal gave out a BINGO card for self care things
- We have a Virtual Coffee Break each day for 20 minutes - first thing in the morning - for our teachers to connect and support one another.
